Leaders' Rules and Regulations

We ask that you observe the following rules and regulations during your time with Illinois Leadership Seminars so that this seminar may be conducted as smoothly and efficiently as possible. **Any participant who does not abide by these rules and regulations will be dismissed from further participation and your parents and school will be notified.**

1. You must attend all activities and meals. Participants are not allowed to leave the facilities of Illinois Wesleyan University during the Seminar. Leaders must stay with your assigned group during all seminar sessions.
2. Name tags must be worn throughout the duration of the seminar.
3. No outside guests are allowed in or around the seminar facility.
4. Protecting the health and safety of participants and our volunteers is paramount. If at any point you are not feeling well, please let our staff know immediately.
5. Have your dorm room key card on your person at all times. Adult staff members are available on each dorm floor if you need assistance. Leaders are not allowed to make room changes. You must be in your assigned room at the announced curfew and must remain in such until the start of activities the next morning.
6. Visiting another dorm room and/or floor than the gender you identify with is not allowed.
7. You must obey bed checks and wake-up calls.
8. No smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages, or unauthorized drug use is permitted.
9. Any leader who has a medical problem or emergency that requires special care, treatment, or medication is asked to inform their group coach or come directly to the Operations Room. There are adult staff members available in case of emergency.
10. You are required to use "Buddy System" when moving throughout the facilities of Illinois Wesleyan University. For all participants under 21 your buddy must also be under 21.
11. Leaders are not permitted to use their cell phones during the seminar program unless instructed to do so.
12. Respect the rights of other Illinois Wesleyan University occupants. Enter only those rooms and areas in which seminar-related activities are being held.
13. ILS has a zero-tolerance discrimination policy.
